Over 1.678 million

Number of Americans of Indian origin in 2000. This represents a 106% increase over 1990.

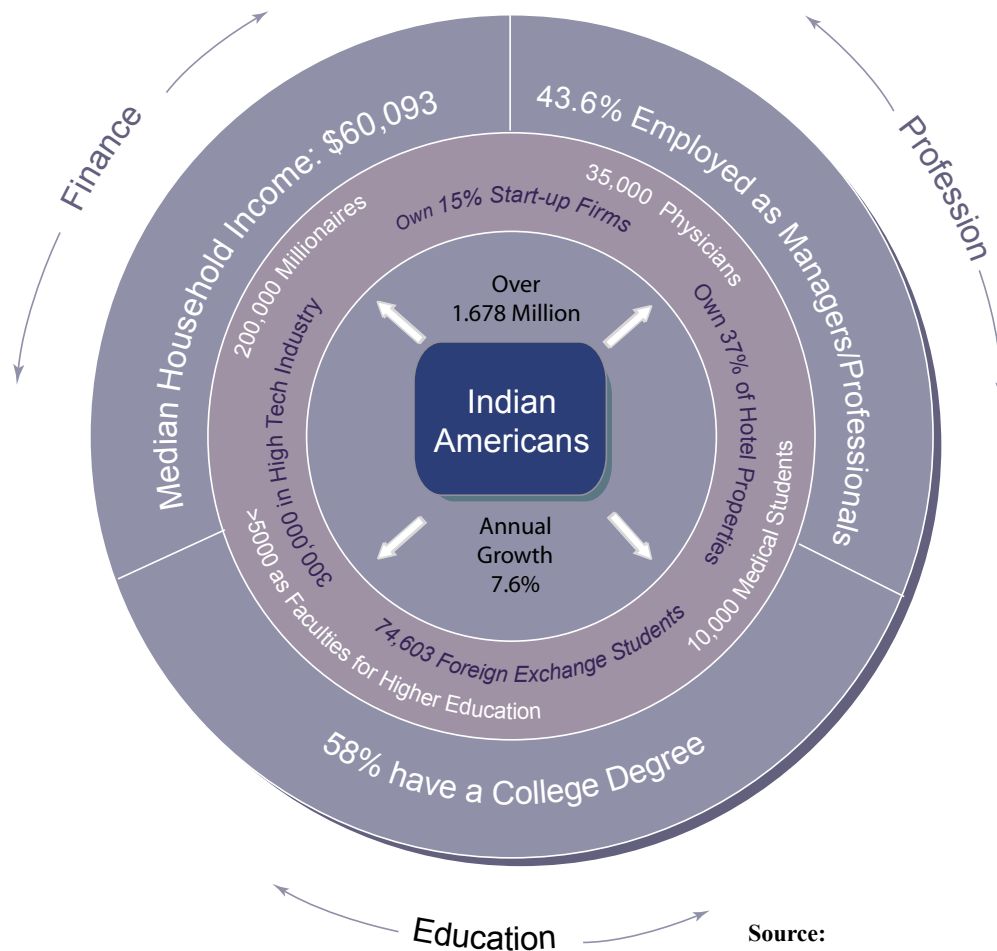

USINPAC is a national, bipartisan political action/education committee of the Indian American community. It represents the community's concerns on a broad range of issues, including immigration, trade, AIDS funding, discrimination, US-India relations and the war of terrorism.

USINPAC provides a strong, clear, principled voice for the Indian American community in our nation's capital. It works with members of Congress of both parties, as well as the administration to ensure that the community's concerns are addressed.

USINPAC has 27,000 active members.

From its founding in 2002 until December 31, 2003, USINPAC raised \$162,286 for candidates. In the same period, it contributed to the campaigns of 15 candidates for federal office, as well as a number of candidates for state and local office.

In 2004, USINPAC's goal is to raise half-a-million dollars for candidates responsive to the community's concerns.
